Active Constituents

Dogs & Puppies- Each tablet contains:

Oxantel Embonate 542 mg

Pyrantel Embonate 143 mg

Praziquantel 50 mg

Large Dogs- Each tablet contains:

Oxantel Embonate 1084 mg

Pyrantel Embonate 286 mg

Praziquantel 100 mg

Actions

For the treatment of tapeworm, roundworm, hookworm & whipworm.

Indications

For the treatment of:

Roundworm (*Toxocara canis*, *Toxascaris leonina*)

Hookworm (*Ancylostoma caninum*, *Ancylostoma braziliense*, *Uncinaria stenocephala*)

Whipworm (*Trichuris vulpis*)

Tapeworm (*Dipylidium caninum*, *Taenia ovis*, *Taenia hydatigena*, *Taenia pisiformis*) plus the Hydatid Tapeworm (*Echinococcus granulosus*).

Does not control Heartworm (*Dirofilaria immitis*).

General Directions

Your dog needs continual protection from parasites such as worms and fleas, with a regular treatment program. To ensure effective worm control, treat all dogs and cats in the household at the same time. Animals infested with worms are a continual source of reinfestation to other animals and may be dangerous to your family. Symptoms of worm infection in your dog are lack of energy, loss of weight and diarrhoea. An important part of the worming program is flea control. Dogs are frequently infested by tapeworm (*Dipylidium caninum*) which uses the flea as a carrier.

Dosage & Administration

Weigh your dog to ensure that you give the correct dose and avoid underdosing.

If worm problems persist, consult your veterinarian.

Wagg & Purr Broad-Spectrum Allwormer Tablets for Dogs & Puppies

Dosage: One tablet per 10kg bodyweight

| Weight (kg) | Dose |
|-------------------|-------------------|
| 1.5 kg to 2.5 kg | ¼ Tablet |
| 2.6 kg to 5.0 kg | ½ Tablet |
| 5.1 kg to 10.0 kg | 1 Tablet |
| Over 10 kg | 1 Tablet per 10kg |

Wagg & Purr Broad-Spectrum Allwormer Tablets for Large Dogs

Dosage: One tablet per 20 kg bodyweight

| Weight (kg) | Dose |
|----------------|-----------|
| 15 kg to 20 kg | 1 tablet |
| 21 kg to 40 kg | 2 tablets |

Puppies

- Treat at **2, 4, 8 & 12 weeks**, then every **3 months** thereafter.

Adult Dogs

- Treat every **3 months**.
- If whipworms are present, treat every 6-8 weeks from 3 months of age.
- In areas where hydatid tapeworm is present, dogs should be treated every six weeks. Dogs should not be fed, or allowed to feed on, offal from any species.

Pregnant bitches

- Treat at mating, before whelping and then every 3 months.

Contraindications

Do not use in dogs under 1.5 kg bodyweight.

Container of 100 tablets.
